

Instructive Tongue

Freemasonry has been called a beautiful system of morality, veiled in allegory, and illustrated by symbols. *Allegory* is from two Greek words and means, "story within a story." Allegory, parable, fable, myth, legend, and tradition, are correlative terms. The myth *may* be founded on fact; the legend and the tradition more probably are founded on fact, but the allegory, parable, and fable, are not. Yet they may be "true" if "true" is not taken to mean factual. All allegories may contain truth, without being fact.

The allegory of the Master's Degree is not true in any factual sense, except the historical background from the Biblical account of the Temple. There is no evidence that Solomon and the two Hirams were Grand Masters; that the workmen on the building were Entered Apprentices, Fellow Crafts and Master Masons; that they met in various apartments of the Temple, with different numbers required for various quorums; that the tragedy occurred; or that the events delineated in the ceremony actually happened.

Yet the allegory is true in the best sense of the word. For the story of Hiram is the story of the dearest hope of mankind. It is a tale told by every religion. It is a Mason's observation that truth, slain by error, will be born again. The Legend of the Third Degree is true in the deepest sense of truth.





Good of the Order by HPM David Reilly

Roy Acuff, Country Singer and Freemason

Roy Claxton Acuff (September 15, 1903–November 23, 1992) was born in Maynardville, Tennessee. Roy Acuff petitioned East Nashville Lodge No. 560 to receive the degrees of Freemasonry. Accepted for membership, he was initiated an Entered Apprentice on November 29, 1943. Subsequently Acuff passed to the degree of Fellowcraft on January 10, 1944 and was Raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on February 21, 1944. Three months later he completed the Scottish Rite degrees and was created a Noble of Al Menah Shrine Temple on June 27, 1944. Eleven years after his Raising, on the last three days of November 1955., Brother Acuff took the York Rite degrees at Edward G. Corbitt Chapter No. 147, R.A.M.; Nashville Council No. 1, R. & S.M. and Nashville Commandery No. 1, K.T., all in the Tennessee capital city. Roy Acuff was invested as a KCCH on October 15, 1979 in the Scottish Rite and was made a 33rd Degree Mason on October 21, 1985.

Roy Acuff was an American country musician, vocalist, songwriter, and fiddler, who was known as the "King of the Hillbillies," the "Caruso of Mountain Music," and the "Backwoods Sinatra." His band was called the Crazy Tennesseans, and later in his career Acuff became a regular on the Grand Ole Opry in 1938. Brother Acuff was seen doing everything at the Grand Ole Opry (Ryman Theater) from cleaning, to in later years acting as co-director for the show. He was inducted into the Country Hall of Fame in 1962. He played and composed The Wreck on the Highway, Beneath That Lonely Mound of Clay, and The Precious Jewel. His theme song became the Great Speckled Bird, but he is also known for the Wabash Cannonball, which was inspired and written about a fictional Hobo traveled train. Many of the actual verses were made up by Hobos themselves who traveled by hopping train cars during the depression looking for work. Brother Acuff once told Box Car Willie to never let people forget the Wabash Cannonball.
