Poinsettia (Pronounced- poyn zet tia)

The plant we know today as the Poinsettia has a long and interesting history. Native to Central America, the plant flourished in an area of Southern Mexico known as Taxco del Alarcon, and was known as the flower of the night. The Aztecs used the plant for decorative purposes but also put the plant to practical use. They extracted a purplish dye for use in textiles and cosmetics from the plant's bracts. The milky white sap, today called latex, was made into a preparation to treat fevers.

The Poinsettia may have remained a regional plant for many years to come had it not been for the efforts of Joel Roberts Poinsett (1779-1851). The son of a French physician, Brother Joel Poinsett was appointed as the first United States Ambassador to Mexico (1825-1829) by President Madison. Poinsett had attended medical school himself, but his real love in the scientific field was botany. (Mr. Poinsett later founded the institution which we know today as the Smithsonian Institution).

Poinsett maintained his own hothouses on his Greenville, South Carolina plantations, and while visiting the Taxco area in 1828, he became enchanted by the brilliant red blooms he saw there. He immediately sent some of the plants back to South Carolina, where he began propagating the plants and sending them to friends and botanical gardens. It is unclear when Poinsett joined the Masonic fraternity. It is documented that he served as Worshipful Master of Recovery Lodge No. 31 in Greenville, South Carolina, and Solomon's Lodge No. 1 in Charleston, South Carolina. He was also a Royal Arch Mason and was elected Grand High Priest of the Grand Chapter of South Carolina, serving until 1841.

Why Do We Salute The Master?

Masons entering or leaving a Lodge salute the Master at the Altar, and as with all symbols, there are several meanings or interpretations:

This practice assures the Master that the brother knows upon which degree the Lodge is open. A brother making the wrong sign can be instructed immediately.

It informs the Master that the brother is a Mason of the degree on which the Lodge is open. If he makes an inferior sign, and cannot, on request, give the correct sign, the Master can use other means to ascertain that no Entered Apprentice or Fellow Craft is present in a Master Mason's lodge.

Brethren salute on retiring to get permission to leave, as no one enters or leaves without the permission of the Master. If the Master does not wish the brother who salutes to retire, he tells him so, instead of responding to the salute.

On busy evenings, as during visitations or other Masonic functions or degrees, the Master may instruct the Tyler to inform entering brethren to salute the Senior Warden in order to not have the labors of the East interrupted.

BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY AND MOST OF ALL: the salute is a reminder to the individual Brother AND a silent assurance to the Master and through him to the Brethren: **“ I remember my obligation. “**

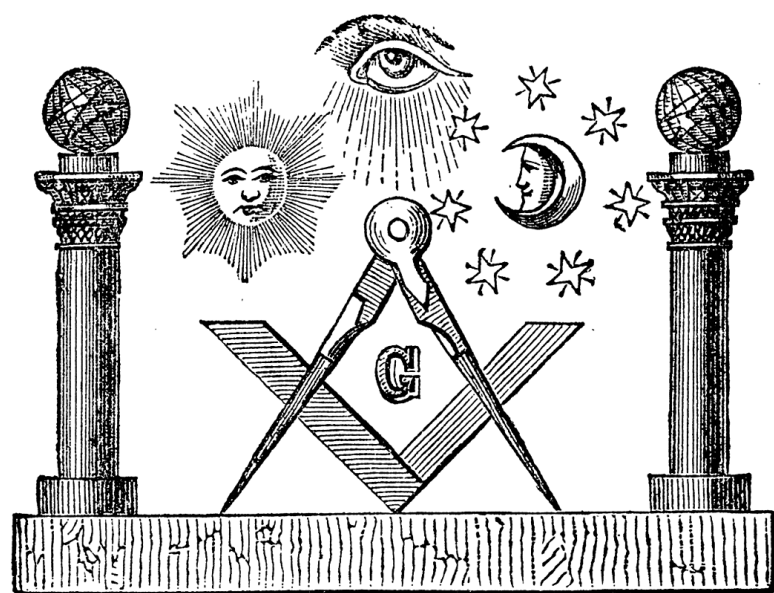
