Dr. John Gorrie: the Father of Refrigeration Good of the Order D. J. Reilly

Dr. John Gorrie was born on October 3, 1803, in South Carolina. He moved to Apalachicola Fl. in 1833. He was on the Founding Committee of the Masonic Lodge No.76 in 1835. He was a Doctor, Postmaster, Member of the City Council and Chairman. He was also the Treasurer and served as Mayor. He held interests in the Mansion House Hotel, two Banks, Apalachicola Land Co., and Founded the Trinity Church in Apalachicola.

In the late 1830's the area in and around Apalachicola had a population around 4,000 and by the end of 1841, the population drastically had dropped to about four hundred. Many died and numerous inhabitants fled the town. One of the many theories in the causation of yellow fever (malaria) was the South's climate with its wide temperature swings. Not to mention the carriers of the disease. (Mosquitos)

Dr. Gorrie a physician, was instrumental in draining swamps and hanging netting to stop Mosquito infestation. He was a pioneer in developing artificial cold. His goal as a physician was to cool the rooms of his home hospital to ease the suffering of his yellow fever and malaria patients. In 1845 he was successful in creating artificial ice by mechanical means. He used this invention to cool the rooms of his patients. His invention was patent no. 8,080, issued on May 6, 1851, for the Improved Process for The Artificial Production of Ice. The invention produced a machine that cooled and created ice. He never made a penny on the patent or the invention. Modern A.C. is based on the principles by Dr. Gorrie. It was rediscovered in 1902 by Willis Harold Carrier.

Grand Lodge Session 2023


