Instructive Tongue


The story of the St. John's Lodge Bible is well known because it is the Bible upon which George Washington took the oath of office when inaugurated President of the United States. This Bible has also been used for the inaugurations of Warren Harding, Dwight Eisenhower, Jimmy Carter and George H. W. Bush. It was intended to be used at the inauguration of George W. Bush, but inclement weather did not permit it. In addition to inaugurations, this Bible was present at the funeral processions of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Andrew Jackson, and Zachary Taylor. It has also been used in the cornerstone laying of the U. S. Capitol, the dedication of the Washington Monument, the centennials of the cornerstone laying of the White House, U. S. Capitol, and the Statue of Liberty. Other Presidents who have made use of the Bible include Andrew Johnson and Gerald Ford.

The Bible was printed in London, taking three years to produce. It contains 103 steel engravings of maps and Old Testament scenes by English artist John Stuart. It is a King James Version, complete with Apocrypha and elaborately supplemented with historical, astronomical and legal data of that period. The Bible was procured for St. John's Lodge by Jonathan Hampton who presented it to the Lodge when he was installed as Master in 1770. The only people allowed to take an oath on this Bible are the President of the United States; the Governor of New York; the Grand Master of Masons in New York; the Master-elect of St. John's Lodge; and Third Degree Candidates of St. John's Lodge. The Bible must be accompanied by 3 members of St. John's Lodge whenever it travels.

The Hidden Degree in Freemasonry By David J. Reilly 33°

In Freemasonry, the hidden degree has been kept a secret for years. The hidden degree is one that is not sought. You cannot ask for it, you don't want it, and you are never prepared for it. Many men and women and even children have acted upon it. Masons have a tendency not to share, even with the connection as a brother, they do not share feelings, nor the problems encountered in life. It is a shame because so many brothers have been through the same problems or will have the same problems on their journey.

The hidden degree is called care giving. Many unknown persons and Masons have been Care Givers. It is not necessarily the responsibility of a spouse, the oldest sibling, or the adult that is educated. While usually a family member, it doesn't always fall to a family member. Care giving comes to the one that has a caregiver's heart. A care giver does not receive accolades of special pins and usually is not even aware of help groups. Many times, the caregiver enters the job as an unknown and learns on the job. While the medical profession assists, it becomes the responsibility of the Care Giver to provide the need for that individual. Many times the patient has an Insurance Policy that gives assistance. A care giver soon finds out with hit and miss tactics that there is not a problem that can't be solved. How wonderful it would be with all the philanthropy that a Mason stands in that if there was knowledge from his brothers that there were solutions, they would share and make sure Brothers had found needed solutions. The Hidden Degree is deep within the brothers who have been caregivers, in the medical profession or in the insurance industry that have some answers and can give direction.

We must reach out to those brothers who find themselves in a Care giving situation. Share good practices, simple solutions, and even stand when a brother is falling apart from the ordeal. While freemasonry teaches us that death may come at any time, and we must be ready, we are to prepare for it and be sure our loved ones are taken care of. No one speaks the truth of care giving. No one tells us of the practices that are available to us through Visiting Nurses, Hospital equipment rental and Hospice. No one tells us of help groups for the care givers. No one tells us about the guilt we have because we feel inadequate or feel we haven't done enough. Know that God is with the Care Giver, God is with the infirmed. As Freemasons we need to stand with our brothers who are giving care. We need to stay vigilant to our Brothers needs and seek out those we don't know about or have not heard from for a while.


